

ACHIEVEMENT TESTING

All students in grades 4-11 will be required to take the achievement tests administered by CCA. High school students who have taken the PSAT, PLAN, or one of the college entrance exams (ACT or SAT) are exempt from the spring achievement tests. Seniors and juniors should take one of these tests.

- 1) If you would like help **preparing** for these tests here are some suggestions. There is a website that offers preparation for all kinds of testing (from the Stanford to ACT/SAT) for about \$20 per year. The web address is learningshortcuts.com. Also, Spectrum books published by McGraw Hill offers test preparation for students up to 8th grade and these can be purchased at Schoolcraft or Burkettes.
- 2) If you have a student with **specific learning difficulties** who will not benefit from this type of testing, please talk to Mrs. DeVine as soon as possible for alternatives.
- 3) All students will be **tested on the grade level printed in the directory** unless we are contacted by the parents.
- 4) If you want your **1st-3rd grader tested**, please send in this form and tell your coordinator at your January conference.
- 5) The cost of testing is **\$15 per student**. Please fill out this form and send your payment and form with your December tuition.
